
- Option 1 Copy & paste from google doc or microsoft word

- Option 3 Attach photos of handwritten response <u>- need to write AP ID and initials on the</u> top of each page
 - Take one photo for each page and attach each separately

Requesting a Make-up Exam

- If you have an issue on Exam day, you will automatically will be directed to a request make-up exam form
- Can access at cb.org/requestmakeup
- Submit within 48 hours of your original exam date
- Only for students who encounter a conflict/error during the test

5 steps to take before Exam day



- 1. Review your contact information
 - a. Sign into your MyAP account to update if needed
 - b. Make sure to click to receive updates in your subscriptions
- 2. Check your tech
 - a. Cannot use Internet Explorer as your browser for the exam
 - b. Will need to disable Grammarly plug-in on your computer if you have it interferes with the exam program
 - c. Submit one document per question
- 3. Practice submitting your response
 - a. On May 4th you can access an AP 2020 Exam Demo at cb.org/apdemo It will allow you to practice different ways to submit your responses
- 4. Gather what you need for each exam
 - a. Required:
 - i. Exam E-Ticket email

- ii. Completed Exam Day Checklist
- iii. Device you are using
- iv. Internet Connection
- v. Microsoft Word, Google Doc, ect. To type answer
- b. Optional:
 - i. Class notes/study guides
 - ii. Textbooks and classroom resources
 - iii. Previous assignments
 - iv. Download to desktop prior to the test
- 5. Receive your exam confirmation and E-Ticket Emails
 - a. On May 4th, students will receive an AP Exam confirmation email and your AP ID
 - b. You will receive your E-Ticket two days before the exam and AP ID

- During the exam do not refresh your browser or click the back arrow
- Check in 30 minutes prior to Exam start by clicking on your E-Ticket
- 45 minutes to read question and develop response
- 5 minutes to submit response
- Timer will be on your screen to help you manage your time and will turn red when you have 5 minutes left

- Be sure to submit your response, even if you are not finished It has to be submitted to be scored
- You shouldn't have to worry about upload time just make sure to click 'submit' prior to the exam time ending

Your testing Environment

- Find a place with limited distractions
- Let you parents and siblings know when you are testing so that they don't disturb you
- If you have limited internet bandwidth, ask others in the home to limit activities with internet use during your exam time (playing video games, netflix, etc.)
